- Talent showcase being held tonight in auditorium
- Cum Laude tapping: approximately 90 students are selected on excellent academic and citizenship accomplishments
 - Ceremony dinner will be held soon, date not announced at this time
- State testing:
 - Eng/LA 7,8,10 grades finish Thursday 3/24, make up testing on Friday and over spring break
 - Math 7,8, Algebra 1, Geometry week on April 18th
- 176 students enrolled currently
 - Mostly 7th graders
 - Last registration event March 24,2022
 - Out of district enrollment will be over the summer in July/August
 - A parent brought up that the enrollment was difficult to find on the website, not outreaching emails sent from what she has seen
 - Smaller numbers all around despite more kids passing the test than previous years
 - If enrollment goes down too much it could affect staffing/budget, Goal is 429 students in 7th grade class

 - Senior awards night is May 24th, cap and gowns will be distributed that night
 - Academic signing day coming up
